- A Grade 12 Certificate (IGCSE) with a minimum of 20 points, including passes in Mathematics, Physical Science, and English, or their equivalents.
- TVET or Vocational Interests: Candidates should be currently studying or have studied in one of the following fields:
 - Electronics
 - ICT / IT
 - Instrumentation
 - Engineering Electronics, Telecommunications, Software Development, Cybersecurity
- TVET students must have achieved an overall average of at least 65% with no failed courses or subjects.
